I understand that:

- Premium payments are applied on the withdrawal date shown on my EFT notice.
- If my account has nonsufficient funds (NSFs) at the time of EFT, QBE will attempt the withdrawal once more before the bank returns the item to QBE as "NSF." A penalty charge will be assessed if the item is returned from the bank. If there are two such returns in one year, EFT will be cancelled by QBE.
- Please allow five business days for changes to your account information.
